- NWSISD provides school choice opportunities in 27 magnet schools across seven school districts. NWSISD placed 5,623 students in grades prek-12, with the magnet school programs impacting a total of 16,370 students. Our magnet schools continue to receive high honors through the Magnet Schools of America Merit Awards Program. Transportation is provided through a management services contract for magnet school students.
- NWSISD provides professional development opportunities to staff members of the sevendistrict collaborative on a monthly basis. Professional Learning sessions are rooted in diversity, equity, and inclusion topics. Some examples are the Bdote' Sacred Sites field trip, Literacy instruction using a Cultural Lens, as well as exploring various ethnic and cultural groups. Participants report 90% or higher of achieving and/or exceeding the stated outcomes.

- Our Multicultural Resource Center has thousands of artifacts to loan out to staff members in our collaborative. The resources provide an opportunity for educators to learn more about specific cultural groups and embed into their existing classroom instruction. Last year over 1400 items were checked out and reached over 37,000 students.
- NWSISD provided mentorship groups and field trip experiences for 506 students promoting college and career readiness and closing opportunity gaps.
