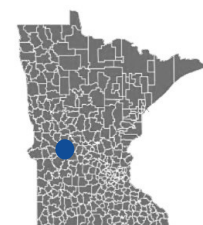




Minnewaska Area Schools is seeking an exceptional leader to serve as Superintendent



Minnewaska Area Schools is located in central Minnesota. The district covers 429 square miles and proudly serves the communities of Glenwood, Long Beach, Starbuck, Villard, Lowry, Farwell, Terrace, Westport, and Sedan. District Points of Lakers Pride include:
